



## Youth Assistance Program Application

Partners of Parks assists children who, for financial reasons, cannot afford to attend a City of Long Beach Parks, Recreation and Marine class or program. To qualify for support:

- \* Youth must be between the ages of 2-17 and must reside in the City of Long Beach
- \* Youth may request assistance for TWO classes per year for a **MAXIMUM** of 2 classes per child, a maximum total of \$150 per child
- \* Partners of Parks will pay for the class fee, up to a **MAXIMUM** of \$75 per class
- \* These funds cannot be used for childcare programs, a **MAXIMUM** of \$75 will be applied to Day Camp fees
- \* Please attach a copy of your **MOST CURRENT** Income Tax Return to this application

## Youth Assistance Program Income Qualifying Guidelines

For a child to qualify for the Youth Assistance Program, the family or household monthly gross income must be equal to or less than the “Monthly Qualifying Income” amount shown in the table below.
